At the **Stubai Glacier**, Austria's largest glacier ski area, the furry mascots B.BIG, Mini B and B.GIANT await little skiers at the BIG Family Ski Camp. Children from the age of four learn to ski in the colourful BIG Family Kinderland, while the youngest ones are well looked after in the BIG Family Kindergarten. Just 45 minutes by car from the Alpine metropolis of Innsbruck, the 3S Eisgratbahn takes you to the Kingdom of Snow on the Stubai Glacier. At 2,900 metres, the glacier offers guaranteed snow from October to June.

The new and special highlight at the Gamsgarten is the enormous Mammut B:GIANT, which is available for family souvenir photos. For all adventure and action fans, the Kingdom of Snow also has a number of fun parks of offer: the BIG Family Boardercross with wave tracks and steep bends, the BIG Family Slalom or the one kilometre long BIG Family Fun Slope are ideal sites where young skiers can go wild. And for the freestyle stars of tomorrow, the BIG Family Slopestyle awaits you with varied rails and obstacles. The ice grotto is equally worth a visit: the mysterious and fascinating world of eternal ice opens up 30 metres below the skiing slope. Children under the age of ten ski for free at the Stubai Glacier when accompanied by a paying parent.

The **Schlick 2000 Skiing Centre**, on the other hand, invites you to the big pleasure challenge in time for its **60th anniversary**. On occasion of the SKI & BBQ SCHLICK 2000 – STUBAI WINTER BBQ CHAMPIONSHIP 2020 from March 13-15, six international top teams will duel from Friday to Sunday at six different lodges across the Schlick 2000 area. In addition to a jury of experts, the opinion of the many guests who can taste the magical barbecue specialities in exchange for vouchers is particularly important. It will be interesting to see who will take home the title of the first Stubai BBQ Champion!

In the meantime, mascot **BIG Ron** will take the children to the Kinderland. The area that comes with great magic carpets, a ski carousel, a wild slalom course, colourful flags and a slalom course, provides fun and entertainment for young and older skiers alike. In BIG Ron's play and warm-up room, babies from age one onwards are welcome without registration; thanks to a sleeping and nappy-changing room as well as a lunch table the little ones are well taken care of and parents can spend a relaxed skiing day.

The ski night show "Night of Colours", which takes place on eight dates in winter at the Froneben Intermediate Station with its colourful, fiery and spectacular programme guarantees amazed children. The subsequent night tobogganing is great fun as well!

Great experiences at the Elfer and the Serles

The three perfectly groomed toboggan runs of the **Elferbahnen** offer plenty of snow fun for the whole family. Three times a week the toboggan run to the village is illuminated at night and the run to the Pinnistal is equipped with lanterns every Friday. Fast descents ensure unforgettable holiday experiences. For the little guests who want to practice skiing, the practice area in Krößbach, where Elfi the ski owl is at home, is exactly the right place. The relatively flat terrain with plate lift and magic carpet is ideal for the first attempts on two boards.

At the **Serlesbahnen in Mieders**, the kingdom of King Serli the foxy weasel, little ski stars are awaited by a picturesque toboggan run and a great children's area right at the Valley Station. Various learning aids such as platter lifts or magic carpets help little skiers to consolidate their first attempts. As always, fun and entertainment are the prime focus.

A special offer are the free lift rides in three ski areas, which all children under 10 years of age can use when accompanied by a paying parent. In addition, some accommodation offers, the BIG Family Premium Homes, are specially designed to meet the needs of children. The Stubaital is the ideal place for a perfect winter holiday together with the whole family!

The Stubaital in Tyrol is close to the state capital of Innsbruck and can best be accessed via the Brenner motorway from Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Italy. With a length of 35 kilometres, surrounded by 80 glaciers and 109 three-thousand metre-summits, the Stubaital and its five main localities Neustiff, Fulpmes, Telfes, Mieders and Schönberg presents itself as an ideal holiday region. The all-season offer attracts above all active holiday-makers: The Stubai Glacier, Austria's largest glacier skiing resort, offers guaranteed snow from October to June.

Since October 2016, the ultramodern **3S Eisgratbahn** with its new Valley Station, renovated intermediate and summit stations, reliably and comfortably takes 3,000 people per hour up to an altitude of 2,900 meters above sea level.

Everything young and older guests require to enjoy perfect skiing pleasures is on offer in the Stubai. Not for nothing the Stubaital has already been distinguished several times as the "family-friendliest skiing resort of the Alps".
